Youville Centre's aim is to provide single parents and their children with the opportunity to acquire the skills needed to become self-reliant members of society. High school and daycare components provide stabilizing structures while social services support aims at recognizing the individual needs of each mother and child, helping them to grow self worth and confidence. The Youville Centre has a track record for success in ensuring that these young parents become self reliant and free from welfare assistance. Over the past year, the Education Foundation has disbursed over \$140,000 to pay for winter coats, boots, hats and mitts, food vouchers, emergency medication such as Epi-pens and other medications where the family cannot afford it, running shoes, emergency transportation, and field trip transportation for thousands of low-income students. In a community as wealthy as Ottawa, it's hard to fathom that many children and young adults come to school on empty stomachs and others have no winter coats or boots. Recent research indicates that over 40,000 children in our city live in poverty. Many of these kids go to our schools
